(WIMBERLEY) – A long time public servant and community leader is stepping down from his position on the Wimberley City Council, Wimberley Mayor Bob Flocke announced Monday.

Place One Council Member and Mayor Pro-tem Charles Roccaforte submitted his letter of resignation to City Hall last Friday afternoon. In his letter, Roccaforte cited the growing demands of his business and personal obligations as the reasons for his departure. The resignation is effective Friday, November 5, 2010.

"We're certainly going to miss Charles," Mayor Flocke said. "He was a steady hand on this council ... he was a good thinker."

Roccaforte was first elected to City Council in May 2007. He was re-elected to a second term on Council in May 2009 – a term which is set to expire in May 2011. Prior to his City Council service, Roccaforte served on the Wimberley Planning and Zoning Commission,

"It has been a privilege to serve the City of Wimberley and its citizens for the last three and one half years," stated Roccaforte in his letter of resignation.

The Wimberley City Council will hold a special meeting on Friday, November 12, 2010, to formally accept the resignation and discuss the options available for filling the vacancy.

"State law is very specific on how a vacancy on a City Council can be filled," said Flocke. "The City Council this week will meet to discuss and consider possible action to fill the vacancy including but not limited to appointing a new member to fill the vacancy, calling a special election to fill the vacancy or providing other direction to City staff regarding the vacancy."

The Special Meeting of the Wimberley City Council will begin at 10 a.m. on Friday, November 12, 2010 at City Hall.


Gentlemen:
