Camp hours will be Monday – Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Pick-up and drop-off will be located at the Community Pavilion at Blue Hole Regional Park. Cost is \$125.00 per week per child. Campers will need to bring a sack lunch and water bottle. While there may be creek-wading for science activities and other water play activities, there is no swimming in the Blue Hole at this camp.
