(WIMBERLEY) – Officials with the Wimberley Rotary Club and the City of Wimberley are inviting residents to a community planning session on Tuesday, September 27th for a proposed "pocket" park on Old Kyle Road.

“This is a great opportunity for the residents of Wimberley to let us know what type of features they would like to see in this small park,” said Mayor Bob Flocke. “The City and Rotary Club will use the ideas presented at the public meeting to develop a master plan for this unique location.”

The Wimberley Rotary Club has offered to assist the City with development of the small park.

“The City greatly appreciates the local Rotary Club’s dedication and commitment to our community,” said Mayor Flocke. “I am confident this partnership between the City and Rotary will produce a tremendous amenity for residents and visitors to enjoy for many years to come.”

The proposed park site is located just east of the Lumberyard Retail Center on Old Kyle Road. It is part of a larger tract of land acquired by the City in 2001 for the Cypress Creek Nature Trail. This past summer, Hays County Sheriff Gary Cutler and inmates from the Hays County Jail cleared the underbrush from the property to assist the City with the park planning process.

The park planning session will take place at the proposed site of the small park. Activities are scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. and last about an hour. Parking is available in the Lumberyard parking lot adjacent to the park site. Refreshments will be available for those attending the meeting.
