**Minutes of Joint Meeting of the City Council  
 & Wimberley Transportation Advisory Board**  
 March 1, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.

City Council meeting called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Bob Flocke.

Council Members Present: Mayor Bob Flocke and Councilmembers Tom Talcott, Mac McCullough, Matt Meeks (arrived at 5:10 p.m.), Steve Thurber, and John White.

Transportation Advisory Board Members Present: Chair Gene Woodruff, Secretary Bert Ray, Members Dorothea Dare, Bob Bullock, and Charles Lancaster. Board members Rodney Jones and Rhett Ryan were absent.

### **Workshop**

A workshop to discuss and consider issues relating to the development of a way finding signage program and other issues relating to transportation in the City of Wimberley

City Administrator Ferguson provided background information and advised of a pending recommendation from Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) regarding future road improvements in accordance with Hays County's Transportation Master Plan. Draft maps of sign locations and content were distributed. Discussion addressed:

- Possible signage additions/deletions for certain destinations
- Wording on specific sign(s)
- Signage for schools
- "Destination" versus "event" signage
- Market Days signage
- Signage placement
- Multi-destination signs
- Color-coordinated signs
- Merchant-specific signs
- Estimated costs for way finding signage program
- Possible use of logos
- Size and scale examples of highway signs
- Eliminating confusion at locations such as the "Y" at Ranch Road 12 and FM 2325

Council agreed on the list of signs as presented by TAB, with the following additions/deletions and name modifications. (Reasoning for deletions included existence of signs already in place or that signs are to be installed by the State at a later date.):

Mayor Flocke called the meeting adjourned at 5:52 p.m.




