

Minutes from  
Economic Development Commission Workshop  
Wednesday, January 16, 2008

Chairman Weeks started the workshop at 5:35 p.m.

Commissioners Gary Weeks, Phil Van Ostrand and Jenelle Flocke were present. Commissioners Temple Wynne and Vivian McDonald were on excused absence. Therefore, a workshop was held instead of the regularly scheduled meeting and, therefore, no action could be formally taken.

Commissioners reviewed the ED plan section on Regional Influences. Commissioner Van Ostrand said he still needed information from the City Administrator (population figures) and the Transportation Advisory Board (future road maintenance and development) before he could complete this section.

Commissioner Flocke's section, "Government," was reviewed and no problems were noted.

Commissioners read the revised input provided by Commissioner McDonald regarding the Civic portion of the draft Economic Development plan and discussed the fact that the last paragraph was redundant (regarding village volunteers) because it was already covered in Commissioner Flocke's section on Government.

Commissioner Weeks distributed a revised graph of the Census 2000 Demographic Profile Highlights and said that it was still a work in progress.

Commissioner Flocke mentioned the sales tax revenue given to the City and it was suggested that it might help the Commission if she compiled this information for the last several years.

Commissioners Weeks and Flocke discussed forming a subcommittee to compile and format relevant information to present to the two new Commissioners to be appointed at the next City Council meeting scheduled for January 17.

Commissioners discussed appointing a subcommittee to write the Executive Summary to the plan. Formal action will be taken at the next EDC meeting on Wednesday, January 30, 2008 at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall.

The workshop ended at 7:07 p.m.
