

Invitation for Bid

The City of Wimberley (the "Owner") invites and will accept sealed bids for the **Blanco Riverbank Restoration Project** in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 221 Stillwater, Wimberley, Texas, 78676 until 2:00 p.m. on October 25, 2016. Any bid received after the bid opening time will be returned unopened.

The scope of work for this Project includes, but is not limited to the restoration and stabilization of the riverbank in the 900-1000 blocks of River Road which will involve the construction of approximately 190 feet of reinforced concrete retaining wall and 2,785 Square feet of reinforced concrete rip-rap. **The Bidder understands that it is responsible for completing this Project as a Standard Workweek contract in accordance with Section 5 of the Supplementary Conditions which amends Article 2 of the General Conditions.**
