

Ordinance No. 2014-021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS, DISSOLVING THE WIMBERLEY BUDGET ADVISORY BOARD; REPEALING TITLE III (ADMINISTRATION), CHAPTER 33 (BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), SECTION 33.05 (BUDGET ADVISORY BOARD), OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING: FINDINGS OF FACT, SAVINGS, SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, EFFECTIVE DATE, AND PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.

WHEREAS, the City of Wimberley (the "City") seeks to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wimberley created a Budget Advisory Board, comprised exclusively of five (5) volunteer members appointed by the Council who are residents living within the City limits, to provide advice to the City Council with respect to budgetary, investment and financial matters; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Budget Advisory Board has completed its work and accomplished the purposes for which it was formed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS:

SECTION I. FINDINGS OF FACT

All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Article as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION II. DISSOLUTION OF BUDGET ADVISORY BOARD

The Budget Advisory Board of the City of Wimberley is hereby dissolved.

SECTION III. REPEAL OF CODE PROVISION CREATING BUDGET ADVISORY BOARD

Title III (Administration), Chapter 33 (Boards and Commissions), Section 33.05 (Budget Advisory Board) of the City of Wimberley Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION IV. SAVINGS

The repeal of any ordinance or part of ordinances effectuated by the enactment of this Article shall not be construed as abandoning any action now pending under or by virtue of such

ordinance or as discontinuing, abating, modifying or altering any penalty accruing or to accrue, or as affecting any rights of the City under any section or provisions of any ordinances at the time of passage of this Article.

SECTION V. SEVERABILITY

Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this Article be adjusted or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Article in whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional.

SECTION VI. REPEALER

The provisions of this Article shall be cumulative of all other ordinances or parts of ordinances governing or regulating the same subject matter as that covered herein; provided, however, that all prior ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with any of the provisions of this Article are hereby expressly repealed to the extent that such inconsistency is apparent. This Article shall not be construed to require or allow any act that is prohibited by any other ordinance.

SECTION VII. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Article shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication as may be required by law.

SECTION VIII. PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Article was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.
