**Public Comments:**

Mary Gibson- Neighbor to the Cypress Creek Nature Trail is reporting that visitors to the Nature Trail are coming into the creek at the water fall and trespassing onto her property. She is asking for help to keep people out of the creek and off her property. Was willing to offer to be apart of a committee to review how to secure and report violations at the park. Had pictures of cedar barriers as a way to control access. Concerned about illegal activities including trespassing, marijuana smoking and nude photography.
