Subject: Emergency Lane

I believe that the TAB should make the following recommendation to the Council for improvements to Emergency Lane:

1. The transformer poles on the south side of the street be moved to the north and if service poles are needed on the south side of the street they be located behind the existing curb.
2. The street section be widened to three lanes (approx.34 feet) from Ranch Road 12 to the driveway which enters the school parking lot. This can be accomplished by paving all the way up to the existing curb on the south side of the street and removing the oak tree on the north side of the street.
3. The culvert at the intersection with Ranch Road 12 be lengthened and appropriate return curves, with a minimum of a 25 foot radius, be installed.
4. The street be striped to provide for a single west bound lane and right turn and left turn lanes on the east bound end and single lanes each direction on the west bound end.

All of these improvements can be accomplished within the existing street right of way without impacting any of the improvements of the adjacent properties which encroach into it. They may not totally solve the congestion on the street during drop-off and pick-up times at the school but they will greatly enhance the usability of the street at all times and not create problems in other areas, i.e. Ace parking lot, FM 2325-RR12 intersection, etc. These improvements can be constructed now and will not be wasted when the future RR12 widening improvements are constructed.

I think we should further recommend that Ace Hardware relocate their dumpster enclosure to remove it from the state highway right of way of FM 2325. This would greatly improve the visibility and safety at the intersection of Emergency lane and Fm 2325.

Please review the attached drawing and call me if you have any questions or suggestions. I am hoping we can agree on a recommendation at our next meeting on April 9.
