### **Minutes of January 16, 2002 Meeting**

#### **Call to Order and Roll call**

The meeting was called to order at 10:00AM by John Graddy. Present were Carolyn Nichols, Bill Johnson, Parker Burgin, Frank Austin, Kelly Kilber, Gene Woodruff, Steve Klepfer, Steve Harrison and John Graddy.

#### **Approval of Minutes of January 2, 2002 Meeting**

Minutes of the meeting were not available. John said that he would catch up on the delinquent minutes at the next meeting.

#### **Status Reports**

##### **911 Address Signs - Nichols**

Carolyn said that the Wimberley Rotary Club is going to handle "marketing" and distribution of the address signs. The city will have no involvement in the program.

##### **Wimberley "Adopt-a-Road" Program**

Carolyn said that the county has created terms of agreement for the program. Volunteers who pick up litter will be allowed to take the litter to the transfer station at with no charge. Betty Smith has agreed to coordinate the program for the city.

##### **7A Ranch Bridge Culverts - Burgin**

Parker said that the fire department doesn't have the equipment needed to clear the culverts. The fire department said that the county did the job the last time that it was needed.

Kelly agreed to check with his contacts with the county and then, if necessary, talk with Ben Picassio, area supervisor, about clearing the culverts.

## **Discussions**

### **Coordination of County Road Work in Village**

This subject was discussed at the previous meeting. The majority of the board is of the opinion that we should leave things as they are now. The county has indicated that they would be interested in bidding of jobs when we solicit contracts.

### **Pothole Repair Demo**

Since Gentry will be inactive for a time, John agreed to contact Chuckholes, Inc. to set up the demo. He said that he would attempt to get a representative to attend a board meeting so that we could schedule a date and time that is agreeable with everyone.

### **Letter to TxDOT**

John has prepared a letter to TxDOT concerning the malfunctioning of the traffic light at the RR12/River Road intersection. Other board members pointed out that he had misunderstood the problem and that the letter was incorrect. John agreed to try again.

### **Action Item Review**

The Action Item list was reviewed and updated.

### **Public Comment**

There was no public comment.

### **Comments by Board Members**

Steve Klepfer said that the parking ordinance had been commented on by the city attorney and would be returned to the board. He asked that the ordinance be finalized at our first meeting in February.

Carolyn suggested that, when we ask TxDOT to investigate the traffic light malfunction at RR12/River Road, we also ask them to install a River Road sign hanging from the light or wires. John suggested that, instead of writing to TxDOT, we may want to call the TxDOT maintenance crew in San Marcos.

Steve Harrison has received a citizen complaint concerning a drainage easement on Flight Acres Road. Steve had pictures and a written complaint. Kelly agreed to investigate.

Bill Johnson said that, since road construction had started on the O'Quinn ranch, problems with deer and feral

hogs had gotten much worse in the immediate neighborhood on Flight Acres Road.
