Minutes of April 3, 2002 Meeting

Call to Order and Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM by John Graddy. Present were Parker Burgin, Al Sander, Frank Austin, Gene Woodruff, Bill Johnson, Kelly Kilber, Carolyn Nichols, and John Graddy.

Approval of Minutes of March 20, 2002 Meeting.

Minutes of the meeting were approved as written.

Status Reports

Purchase of Barriers - Burgin

Parker has finished putting together a list of barriers, signs, and safety equipment to be purchased. The board approved a recommendation to request the city council to approve funding in the amount of \$7000 to purchase the equipment.

Palos Verdes Culvert - Woodruff

Gene has completed the application for a permit to do work on the TxDOT RR12 right-of-way.

Chuckholes, Inc Work - Woodruff

Gene reported that Chuckholes, Inc. has completed the installation of five loads of material. Roads receiving repairs were Hillview and Mesa Drive in Spoke Hill, Brinkley Drive, Hilltop and Climbing Way in Paradise Hills, Blue Hole Road, and Loma Vista. They also filled numerous potholes as they traveled to designated roads. Gene reported that all work appeared to be satisfactory.

Discussion

Potholes Plus

John reported that the city has received information on a company, Potholes Plus, which does the same type of work as Chuckholes, Inc. He said that he had contacted the company, and, it appears that the equipment used, material used, and cost were very similar to Chuckholes, Inc. He suggested, and the board approved, having Potholes Plus give a demo of their

capabilities at our next meeting.

RR12 Erosion Control

Steve Klepfer had requested the addition of this item to the agenda. Steve was not present to discuss the item.

Funds Request to City Council

It was recommended and agreed to request funding in the amount of \$5000 to clear the culverts under the 7A Ranch bridge and to replace the protective grates.

Public Comment

Comments by Board Members

Carolyn said that there has been no work on placing city limit signs because of the disagreement with TxDOT on where they should be placed.

John asked if we would have to work with TNRCC or some other state agency if we have to dredge rock and silt from the river. Kelly suggested that Alan Walther with the county Environmental Health Department may be able to advise us on this subject.
