Minutes of April 17, 2002 Meeting

Call to Order and Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM by John Graddy. Present were Gentry Carr, Parker Burgin, Al Sander, Frank Austin, Gene Woodruff, Bill Johnson, Kelly Kilber, and John Graddy. City Administrator Steve Harrison also attended.

Potholes Plus Demonstration

The board accompanied Potholes Plus personnel to River Road for a demonstration of their road repair capabilities. A large pothole was filled. Potholes Plus also agreed to repair a badly damaged road edge. Board members then returned to city hall for their regular meeting.

Approval of Minutes of April 3, 2002 Meeting.

Minutes of the meeting were not available. They will be reviewed at the May 1 meeting.

Status Reports

Funds Request to City Council- Graddy

John reported that the previously agreed to fund requests had not been presented to the council. After a long discussion of why the presentation had not been made, it was agreed that the city administrator would submit all agreed to items at the next council meeting.

Palos Verdes Culvert - Woodruff

Gene reported that he has received the permit to do work in the TxDOT right-of-way. Steve Harrison said the the city engineer is preparing the bid specification and cost estimates in preparation for soliciting bids.

Discussion

Additional Work for Potholes Plus/Chuckholes, Inc.

John recommended requesting funding from the council for either Potholes Plus or Chuckholes, Inc. to do repair on Smith Creek Road and Rocky Springs Road. He said that both roads are badly in need of repair since the November flood.

Most board members favor having Chuckholes, Inc. do the work. The consensus is that Chuckholes, Inc. uses higher quality material and does a better job of installation.

It was agreed to request funding of up to \$4000 for these repairs.

RR12 Erosion Control

Steve Klepfer had requested the addition of this item to the agenda. Steve was not present to discuss the item.

Meeting with County Roads Department

John recommended scheduling a follow-up meeting with the county roads department to discuss county maintenance assistance and a division of responsibility between the city and county. Steve Harrison agreed to schedule the meeting.

Public Comment

There was no public comment

Comments by Board Members

Gentry raised the issue of not allowing left turns from RR12 onto Old Kyle Road. The board requested that Gentry continue to investigate this for possible implementation. Gentry will also talk with TxDOT about possible changes to the traffic light at RR12 and River Road.
