**MINUTES:**

Minutes of the April 11, 2007 meeting were reviewed and approved without change.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** None

**A. SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS:** None

**B. PUBLIC WORKS REPORTS:**

1. Low-water Crossings: Bill Bowers reported that the Little Arkansas crossing was open but had suffered some vandalism damage to the gates. The Blanco-1492 and Hidden Valley crossings were still closed. "Closed" signs are posted at those locations.

The city is in the process of correlating the USGS water level numbers with the markings on the water gauges.

2. Pothole Repair: Bob Ronson announced that the pothole repair program has been implemented, but the recent rains have put it on hold.

**C. CITY ADMINISTRATION REPORTS:**

1. Water Level Notice: Don Ferguson said that the City is hoping to establish a website to allow citizens to be aware of local water levels and to alert them of danger or closings.
2. Pedestrians and Traffic on River Road: The City is looking into the traffic/pedestrian conflicts with private property along River Road to see if some sort of definition and control can be implemented. The City is also continuing to study signage, and has requested that the City Engineer make an evaluation of the bank erosion and the large stone blocks alongside the road.

**E. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION:**

1. Transportation Master Plan Public Hearing: The Transportation Master Plan Subcommittee made a PowerPoint presentation of the draft Plan in order to receive public input. No comments were noted. Therefore, the Board voted to approve the Plan and recommend that it be sent to the Planning and Zoning Commission for their review and another public hearing.

**F. ANNOUNCEMENTS AND REQUESTS FOR FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:**

1. Parking at Nature Trail: There was discussion at an earlier TAB meeting regarding the problem of people parallel parking along the Nature Trail curb, partially blocking the westbound lane of Old Kyle Road and creating a dangerous situation. The original plans for the Trail envisioned this as a no-parking area, but the prohibition must be formally implemented by Council. A recommendation to Council on this topic will be an Action item at the next TAB meeting.
