Minutes Transportation Advisory Board - July 10, 2002

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Frank Austin.

Present: Frank Austin, Bill Johnson, Kelly Kilber, Gentry Carr, John Graddy, Gene Woodruff, Al Sander, Parker Burgin, and Steve Harrison.

Procedure to Appoint New Board Members. Steve Harrison discussed the Council plan in progress on a Procedure to Appoint New Board Members. Frank Austin commented that the Board is two members short and that we need replacements as soon as possible as Board will lose 2-3 more members at term end in September.

Proposed 2003 City Budget. Gene Woodruff presented Board with priority list of roadwork yet to be completed within 2002 budget at a total cost of \$276,000. Gene Woodruff also submitted list of roads needing mowing and brush cutting.

Comprehensive Plan. Copies of the proposed Comprehensive Plan were distributed to all Board members for their review and to be discussed at the next meeting.

Public Comments

Roberta Holland—County has done as much work as they can on drainage problem. County cannot do any work on private property. Estimated cost to finish job is \$2-3,000. TAB will review situation with legal department and engineer and report back next meeting.

Raymond St. German—requested review of speed limits on RR12 at South River/Paradise Valley intersections. Reduced speed limits have been requested of TxDOT.

Dorothy Hook—Creek Crossing on Spoke Hollow Drive at Story property under water 6 to 8 inches for 3 to 4 days. Needs additional culverts. Gene Woodruff will investigate and report back to Board.

Board Comments

Gentry Carr—Working toward getting “Scenic Road” designation for several roads.

Parker Burgin submitted cost proposal to purchase signage and road barricades. He stated that the rental charges for two parades would equal cost to purchase.

Estimates for signage and banner costs:

Signs & barriers/trailer to haul	\$2,000
Storage—55'x12' per year.	600

A motion was made to present a request to City Council to provide \$20,000 in the 2003 Budget for a "Public Works" official to handle road matters.

Gentry Carr indicated that Hays County will mow all 39 miles of City roadway twice a year for \$7,500.
