Citizen Comments:

Dave Slider complained of the danger posed by sight limitations at the intersection of Wayside Drive and River Road. He suggested that a 3-way stop sign might alleviate the problem. TAB will put it on the agenda for the next meeting for consideration.

Agenda Items

- A) 1) Ricky reported that the road contractor is working and that we have mowing operations going.
- 2) Road Evaluation Form- Kelly discussed the combined matrix and said it was basically complete. Kelly, Craig, and Ricky said they believed it was a TAB working form and that it wasn't necessary to go to council for approval. However, council person Nichols has indicated that she thought it was to be approved by council. Kelly is making the final corrections. TAB will note to approve it at the next meeting.
- 3) The budget that the city administrator presented to the council was his original proposal and not the one advised by TAB, which was presented to the council by Craig Payne.
- 4) a) Ranch Road #12 @ Spoke Hollow Road  
      Kelly met with the Kneisses and Mary Nall. The Kneisses said that they would donate the land for the new R.O.W. They would like the area between the old and new R.O.W. lines to be maintained as green space. Ricky requested that Kelly ask Gene Majors to draw up R.O.W. deeds to the City from the Kneisses and Ms. Nall. The county road department is ready to go to work.
- b) Alignment of Texan Blvd. and Las Flores Drive is on hold.
- c) We discussed the combined problem of the low water crossing @ Hays County Road #1492 and the intersection of River Road and Wayside Drive. Mark suggested that we might use paint striping to indicate the no parking zones at each end of the crossing. Some suggested that we put 3-way stop signs at River Road and the crossing as well as at River Road and Wayside Drive. Kelly and Ricky suggested that we have a traffic study done from Blanco Bend through to River Road and Wayside Drive. Kelly recommended we take a traffic

count there and Ricky suggested we get a traffic engineer to tell us where to put the counters.

d) Drainage Problem @ Bluehole Lane and the Cemetery

The church and the cemetery groups are getting together on this.

5) Possible council re-certification of Official Road Inventory

- Craig thought Deer Crossing needed to be added to the list and Cliffview and Hinson deleted. Some said they thought that the council couldn't delete them once they were on the list. Craig is going to draft a recommendation for the next meeting that Bluehole Road and Bluehole Lane are only one street and its name should be Bluehole Lane.

6 & 7) Weeds and Junk Cars Ordinances

Kelly recommended these be retained as action items so we could discuss this after we review them.

8) Mill Race Lane Project

Several suggestions were made: a) Have the R.O.W. surveyed, b) Recycle the existing road surface and reconstruct the road where it is, c) Do the original proposed repair work, and d) Do a single course repair for now. Kelly is going to try to put some numbers on it by next meeting so we can make a choice. Carrol suggested we have a traffic count there by next meeting.

9) Kelly will have the revised road matrix by next meeting.

B) Reports

TAB would like to use our labor to utilize the traffic counters TAB requested. Councilman Czichos will ask the city administrator what we need to do for TAB to gain access to the counters.

Kelly asked us to consider the cross walks @ the square and the intersections of pedestrian and vehicular traffic because they are poorly marked. He suggested a painting plan for them.
