Minutes Transportation Advisory Board – September 11, 2002

Frank Austin called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

Present: Frank Austin, Bill Johnson, Gene Woodruff, Bob Bullock, Craig Payne, Gentry Carr, Councilman John Graddy, City Administrator Steve Harrison, and Code Enforcement Officer Rickey Wright.

Minutes of the August 28, 2002 Transportation Advisory Board Meeting we approved as written.

Don Nyland, Joe Holland, Scott Cunningham and Lisa Brundrett, TxDOT representatives, made a presentation on the Village of Wimberley Comprehensive Traffic Plan. TxDOT submitted a report entitled "Report on Traffic Conditions – Wimberley, Texas," dated September 9, 2002 to committee members and city management. All aspects of TAB traffic study were included and discussed in detail by TxDOT representatives. Specific detail was given to: speed limit considerations, traffic signal locations, drainage problems, intersection of RR12 and 3237, a left turn lane to Old Kyle Road at the Square, the proposed "bypass", installation of city limit signs and the traffic hazards at Texas Blvd. At 2325, ordinance to create the Transportation Advisory Board was approved by the TAB with amendment to include in Section III a provision for bicycle pathways.

Resignation of Parker Burgin from the TAB was accepted with regret.

Steve Harrison confirmed Board Member terms and will report back to Board at next meeting concerning whether or not new members appointed to replace those whose terms would have expired in September 2002. May have to be reappointed by council.

Review of ongoing "Action Items" was postponed until next meeting.

Request for Square Area Signage Appropriation by Gentry Carr was postponed until next meeting.

Frank Austin reminded Board that his term as Chairman is expiring at the end of September and the Board should be considering candidates for new chairman, vice-chairman and secretary.

Frank Austin reported that the meeting of the Parking Ordinance Review Committee would be held Tuesday, September 17, 2002 – 7:00 p.m. at the Visitor's Center.

Meeting adjourned at 12:30 p.m.

Representatives of TxDOT agreed to stay for further discussion concerning any and all aspects of the traffic study. Discussion continued until 2:00 p.m.
