Frank is resigning. One year ago, his term was up but he agreed to serve for another year.

A. Consider & Possible Action Items:

1. Discussion of Status of Current Road Maintenance and Repair

Road projects to start on September 29<sup>th</sup>

Frank says that the shoulders of Ranch Road #12 south of the Square are in bad repair. We should initiate a request to TxDOT to repair them.

2. Discussion on recommending signage change on River Rd. at Wayside, River Rd. and #1492 river crossing, and traffic counts

Pending traffic counts

Rickey and Gene are going to set up counters at Mill Race Lane today.

3. Discussion of the following project/ items:

a. Ranch Road #12 and Spoke Hollow

The Knieses want the small area between the old and new R.O.W.s to be maintained as greenbelt.

b. Alignment of Texan and Las Flores

Nothing is happening on this. It's on permanent hold. John G. suggests we collect some data because the council doesn't understand the problem.

c. County Road #1492 approach to low water crossing with regards to no parking at or near the low water crossing

Kelly suggests that we put "No Parking" sign on the safety warning sign because the "No Parking" signs face the wrong way..

d. Drainage situation on Blue Hole Lane with regards to cemetery

We don't know of a meeting time with the cemetery people and the church people.

e. Signalization of Square

Rickey says TxDOT is still studying this.

f. Pedestrian cross walks on the Square

Frank says that this is a big problem and getting worse. Kelly has suggested repainting the walks and placing warning placards.

4. Discussion of Modifications to and possible Council recertification of Official Road Inventory List

Carroll submitted this list the last time but it didn't make it onto the agenda. It will be on the next City Council agenda.

5. Discuss the proposed Mill Race Lane project, traffic counts

Frank thinks Mill Race Lane needs an in-depth, comprehensive study. Waiting for traffic counts.
