Residents on the south central side of Wimberley will get an opportunity to provide input on the need for street improvements at an upcoming neighborhood meeting on Tuesday, December 9th. The meeting, organized by the City of Wimberley Transportation Advisory Board, will take place at 6 p.m. at the Cypress Creek Church located at 211 Stillwater.

“We encourage residents in the Paradise Valley, Paradise Hills, Spoke Hollow and Spoke Hill neighborhoods to attend the upcoming meeting (December 9th) to let the Transportation Advisory Board know what, if any, public streets need to be improved,” said Board Chairman Gene Woodruff. “The Board is interested in hearing about streets in their neighborhood, as well as in other parts of the city.”

The meeting is the second in a series of nine neighborhood meetings that will be held across the city by the Transportation Advisory Board between now and May 2015. After neighborhood meetings, the Board will hold a community meeting where those residents who were unable to attend their individual neighborhood meetings can participate in the public involvement process.

Input received in the community outreach effort will be used by the Board to develop a prioritized street improvement list that will be presented to City Council in late May or early June of 2015.

“The purpose of these meetings is to learn from residents and property owners about what, if any, public streets in the city they would like to see improved and to discuss the funding of future street improvements,” said Woodruff. “We need public involvement and input in this outreach effort.”
