Minutes of February 22, 2001 meeting

Members Present: Anderson, Baker, Gumbert, Hollon, Moore, Persohn, Klepfer
Guests: Peg Tharp, Woodcreek City Administrator

Water Testing Program: Baker gave a review of the presentation made by Debbie Magin of GBRA at our previous meeting. Cypress Creek is on the 303d list of impaired streams due to occasionally low dissolved oxygen concentrations. Klepfer will check if being on that list would affect a CCN application. We should try and get the data collected by a group of volunteers since 1984 included in the data of the Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP) that is administered by the GBRA as this would better indicate long term water quality trends. Approved Debbie Magin's request that David Baker serve on the steering committee of the Clean Rivers Program for the Guadalupe River Basin.

The Quintana Group that is looking into building town houses on the approximately 140 acres adjacent to Blue Hole would be interested in turning the Blue Hole CCN over to the Village if the Village and GBRA develop a treatment facility. There is still time to protest renewal of this CCN.

Aqua Source Stream Discharge Permit request: TNRCC is requesting more information from A/S. Long term project.

A/S CCN and Rate case: Asking administrative law judge to dismiss or abate the case since A/S does not automatically get the CCN of Woodcreek System when A/S purchased Woodcreek System. Water/Waste Water Board recommends that the Village support House Bill 1281 of the Texas Legislature, that would prevent state wide utility rates.

Inspection Tour of A/S facility: Gumbert will coordinate with GBRA and Mayor Hewlett to get a letter from Village to A/S requesting one of three inspection dates. They may deny the request but we need to get it in writing. In future will also need to inspect Blue Hole Facility.

Persohn reported that the request for On Site Sewage Facilities Permit will be accepted by Hays County Environmental Health Department when owner presents a building permit from the Village.

Aqua Source line inspection: the Mandrill tests were received and are satisfactory. Aqua Source does not have permit for Phase 2 plant. Pump station there not completed.

Recommendations from this board to the Planning Commission regarding subdivision regulations based on water availability will need to be based on scientific data that is not available at this time. Until this data is available

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recommend that the regulations used by Hays County for water availability in subdivisions be adopted.

Discussion about the need to monitor water availability and to have drought contingency plan.
