Citizens' comments There were no citizen's comments.

Minutes Minutes of February 16, 2005 were reviewed and approved.

1. Reviewed the transportation master plan in relation to the proposed wastewater treatment plan and collection system.
2. Inspection has shown that there needs to be completely new restrooms at Blue Hole. The existing facility is run down and the septic tank is cracked.
3. Deer Creek wastewater treatment continues to have high BOD. If they are using an old x-ray machine it could be discharging antibodies that counteract the bacteria used to lower BOD.
4. Pigg reported that the Industrial Wastewater Ordinance draft is almost ready and is based on EPA regulations and Texas House Bill 1979.
5. Horace Wilson, chairman of the Parks Board gave a report on the Nature Trail progress in particular with regard to restrooms. The Texas Parks and Wildlife Grant does not include funding for restrooms but does include \$20,000 discretionary funds. Bids for a 4-toilet restroom were over three times that amount.
6. Motion was passed appointing Frederick and Pigg to represent this board on a committee that is looking into alternatives for restrooms on the east side of Cypress Creek.
