Minutes Minutes of January 25 and March 22, 2005 were reviewed and approved.

Citizens' comments Todd Mackenzie, Deer Creek Administrator, commented that he is frustrated by the lack of progress regarding an adjustment of the waste water fees that Deer Creek pays to the Village.

Sewer System Impact Fees and Monthly Charges Mayor Klepfer gave a review of the efforts to get a sewer system for Wimberley. Councilman Nichols presented a report on possible impact fees and monthly charges for sewer system customers. Report is attached to these minutes. Representatives David Welch, John Smith and Darrell Ball from GBRA joined in a discussion of types of sewer treatment plants. The membrane plant is the latest technology. It is a little more expensive but has better odor control and can be hidden inside a barn type structure. Fees will be high as they are the only source of revenue.

Customer Connection Ordinance Burleson reported his committee has not found a city with an ordinance that fits Wimberley. Wright suggested contacting the Texas Municipal League.
