Minutes of October 18, 2004 Meeting 5:30 p.m. Wimberley City Hall

Minutes of September 27, 2004 meeting approved

Citizens' comments There were no citizen's comments

New board member, Rick Burleson was introduced.

The presentation given by David Venhuizen at our September meeting regarding decentralized system rather than a central sewer system was discussed at some length. While the idea might have merit there were concerns about using it for Wimberley due to the terrain, state regulations, density of the user locations in the proposed Wimberley Square area.

Estepp presented a revised plan for the renovation of the Blue Hole Restrooms. Burleson mentioned the necessity of complying with ADA requirements for public facilities.

Frederick presented a report: Wastewater Flow Projections for the Preliminary Planning of the VOW/GBRA Wastewater Treatment Plant. The report was based on canvassing the proposed customers and estimating their usage. Total estimated usage is 39,800 gpd plus 10,000 gpd from Deer Creek Nursing Facility. The proposed treatment plant is planned for 50,000 gpd.

Wright reported that Deer Creek is improving their BOD and nearing the 100 BOD target.

Anderson reported the 10/11/04 e-coli readings taken by the volunteer group. Blue Hole and the Square are significantly higher than the rest of Cypress Creek, (387 and 326 respectively).
