3. **PRESENTATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION**

- 3.1. Consider approval of Ordinance 2023-02, to extend the severe freeze and winter weather event local disaster declaration.

A motion was made by Council Member Shell, seconded by Council Member Cohen to approve Ordinance No. 2023-02, that extends the severe winter weather event local disaster declaration, as presented. The motion carried by a vote of 4-0, with Council Member Sheffield being absent.

- 3.2. Discuss and consider possible action related to the winter freeze.

Tim Patek, City Administrator, provided information related to the efforts being made by City Staff on debris removal within the City, communication with the County for additional support, the documentation of volunteer hours, and that messaging to the community will continue as additional information is available. Mayor Fulkerson informed everyone that the Austin Disaster Relief Network (ADRN) is working with local churches and stated that if residents are in need of clean-up, they can submit a request. All information can be found on the City's Website. Upon completion of discussion, a motion was made by Council Member Minnick, seconded by Council Member Cohen to authorize up to an additional \$15,000 for the City Administrator to use for labor, materials or other items needed in relation to the ice storm. The motion carried by a vote of 4-0, with Council Member Sheffield being absent.

A motion was made by Council Member Cohen, seconded by Council Member Shell, to adjourn the special meeting at 12:24 p.m. The motion carried (4-0).
