

RESOLUTION NO. 13-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY SURPLUS (WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO DISPOSE OF SAID PROPERTY IN THE MANNER MOST ADVANTAGEOUS TO THE CITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Wimberley recently commissioned a new wastewater collection system; and

WHEREAS, the City will no longer treat water utilizing the wastewater treatment plant located at Blue Hole Regional Park; and

WHEREAS, the removal of wastewater treatment facilities can accumulate additional costs when not disposed of properly; and

WHEREAS, the wastewater treatment plant has been determined to no longer have a use for the City of Wimberley and staff respectfully requests it to be declared surplus; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Wimberley, Texas hereby declares the wastewater treatment plant as surplus property and authorizes the sale or donation of said property in accordance with the forgoing legislative findings.



Section 3. That it is officially found, determined and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this ordinance, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval.
