- 8.1. Parks Director Report regarding the 2022 swim season, programs/events and maintenance projects. (*Parks Director, Richard Shaver*)

Parks Director, Richard Shaver, presented a report detailing the department's involvement in the Texas Recreation and Parks conference, application for Texas Parks and Wildlife grants, upcoming events, an update on the new park offices, an update on swim season sales, and recruiting activities for the 2022 swim season.

- 9.4. Discuss and consider possible action to accept a donation from the Friends of Blue Hole for Concerts in the Park and park improvements. (*Parks Director, Richard Shaver*)

Parks Director, Richard Shaver, presented the item. **Motion to accept \$2,400 for Concerts in the Park and \$200 for plants for the office flowerbed from the Friends of Blue Hole was made by Council Member Christine Byrne. Motion was seconded by Council Member David Cohen. Motion carried unanimously (5-0).**

- 9.1. Discuss and consider possible action to select Post Oak Preservation Solutions to assist with the development of preservation solutions protecting the unique character of the City. (*Place Two Council Member, Teresa Shell*)

Representatives from Post Oak Solutions gave a presentation outlining the process for developing historical districts. **Motion to select Post Oak Solutions to assist with the development of preservation solutions to protect the unique character of the City was made by Council Member Teresa Shell. Motion was seconded by Council Member Christine Byrne. Motion carried unanimously (5-0).**

- 9.2. Discuss and consider options for the sign structure located at Ranch Road 12 and River Road within the city right-of-way due to the dilapidated condition of the sign structure. (*City Administrator, Mike Boese*)

There was discussion regarding issues and possible solutions to managing the sign structure on River Road.

No action was taken.

- 9.3. Discuss and consider possible action regarding an interlocal agreement between Hays County and the City of Wimberley for floodplain administration and environmental health services. (*City Administrator, Mike Boese*)

City Administrator, Mike Boese, presented the item, noting that the staff member previously performing the majority of these duties had resigned. **Motion to approve the interlocal agreement between Hays County and the City of Wimberley for floodplain administration and environmental health services was made by Council Member David Cohen. Motion was seconded by Council Member Jim Chiles. Motion carried unanimously (5-0).**

- 9.5. Discuss and consider possible action regarding the allocation of funds to purchase directory map signage to orient visitors to areas of interest within the City. (*Place One Council Member, Rebecca Minnick*)

Council Member Rebecca Minnick presented the item. **Motion to purchase directory map signage was made by Council Member Rebecca Minnick. Motion was seconded by Council Member David Cohen. Motion carried unanimously (5-0).**

There were no future agenda items.

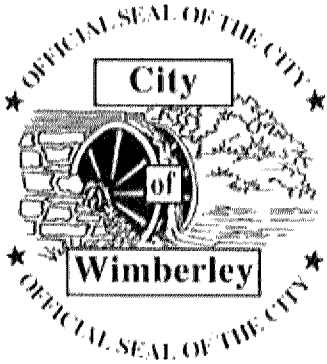
## 11. ADJOURNMENT
