



Blue Hole Regional Park Rules and Regulations



The following rules and regulations have been established for the safety and enjoyment of users of Blue Hole Regional Park. Additional rules regarding the use of specific areas of the park follow this list that applies to all areas:

All swimming is at your own risk.

Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult.

No dogs, cats or other animals allowed in the swim area. Service animals are allowed.

Prohibited Behaviors:

Jumping from trees in the park except at designated swings.

Use of foul language and lewd behavior.

Consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages.

Smoking in the park or parking lot.

Use of drugs and/or weapons.

Disorderly conduct.

Use of glass containers.

Excessive noise.

Fishing.

Soliciting.

Use of fires, stoves or cooking of any kind.

No garbage or other solid waste may be dumped or littered in the park.

Garbage associated with park use must be deposited in containers provided.

Any violation of park rules may result in immediate removal from the park.

The City of Wimberley is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items.

Personal grills/ cookers are not allowed. We have designated grilling stations located throughout the park that are free to use if we are not on a burn ban.

Guests are permitted to bring food and beverages (no glass or alcohol), coolers, pool floats, and shade canopies (10X10) into the swimming area.
