Meeting called to order by Board Chairperson Christine Byrne at 5 P.M.

1. Citizen communication: none
2. Rebecca gave to the Board the presentation she will be giving to the City Council regarding the decisions made during our workshop for the reservation system at Blue Hole Regional Park.
3. Friends of Blue Hole Activity Report: Friends of Blue Hole Executive Director Susan Nenney reports that Friends will be supporting Boo Hole and Blue Christmas as seasonal events this year. The Hershey Grant training will take place on November 17th. 31 Staff and volunteers will receive training on restoring the uplands. Drawings have been ordered for the playground/picnic canopy. Christine adds that there have been lots of volunteers on Wednesdays and that they have been able to remove all of the Johnson's grass and cedar saplings.

 - i. New fees will be as follows: Pavillion \$30 per hour resident/\$60 non-resident, Amphitheater \$20/\$40, Picnic Area \$20/\$40, Volleyball Court \$5/\$10, Basketball court \$5/\$10, Firepit \$5/\$10
 - b. The Rec and Leisure off-season permit discussion was tabled until the full board is present.
 - c. Discussion of a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Wimberley and the Cypress Creek Nature Preservers Committee was tabled.
