RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH HAYS COUNTY TO PROVIDE INSPECTION OF ON-SITE SEWAGE FACILITIES AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND SANITATION BY THE HAYS COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT.

Alderman Tony McGee made the motion that we resolve to authorize the Mayor to sign the agreement as submitted to the Village in signed form by Hays County. The Village does not have staff to inspect on-site septic systems as it is currently being done by Hays County and under this agreement they would continue to perform this service and continue to collect the fees for said services. Financial arrangement for those services would remain the same. We must agree to adopt the rules for onsite facilities that are currently in place in Wimberley through Hays County. Walter Brown seconded the motion and pointed out that under Section 7 of this agreement, any deviation from Hays County rules for on-site facilities must be adopted by separately enacted ordinance by the Village and, accordingly, we are not bound to do exactly what the county does and no more. Alderman Klepfer also commented that any application for service has to be reviewed by the city. Motion carried 5-0. (Attachment VII).
