

Village of Wimberley  
Resolution to Create  
Water/Wastewater Advisory Board  
Wimberley City Council

**Whereas** the Village of Wimberley is authorized by the Legislature to regulate matters relating to water and waste water within its jurisdiction, and

**Whereas** the Village of Wimberley City Council requests advice and participation from citizens and experts regarding water and wastewater matters, now

**Be it resolved by the Wimberley City Council:**

That The Village of Wimberley Water/Wastewater Advisory Board be established, and

That the Board consist of seven members, and

That each councilman and the mayor appoint one member each, and

That one member be appointed by consensus of the council, and

That not more than three of the members of the Board reside outside the Village, or its ETJ, and

That the Board shall elect a chairman from its members, and

That the terms of the Board members shall be two years with the exception that three members shall be elected to an initial three year term, and

That ex-officio membership be extended to Hays County Environmental Health Department, Wimberley Water Supply, Guadalupe Blanco River Authority, Hays County Water Conservation District, Wimberley Valley Water Shed Association, Wimberley Neighbors for Healthy Water, Texas Natural Resources Conservation Commission, the City of Woodcreek, and

That the Board is charged with the duty to advise the council on all matters relating to water and wastewater within the Village of Wimberley and its ETJ.
