RESOLUTION CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 2000 TO ADOPT A MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX AS AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER 321 OF THE TEXAS TAX CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, HAYS COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, there was held in the Village of Wimberley, Hays County, Texas on the 7th day of November, 2000, an election to adopt a one percent municipal sales and use tax within the Village of Wimberley and it appearing from the returns that there was cast at said election, by the duly qualified electors of said City, 926 votes of which there was cast for the sales tax election, the following number of votes, to-wit:

All as reflected by said official election returns heretofore submitted to the City Council of said City by Joyce Cowan, Hays County Election Administrator, and accepted by said City on the 13th day of November, 2000, as the official results of the sales and use tax election of November 7, 2000 and declare that such election imposed the one percent sales and use tax within the Village of Wimberley; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS:

That said election was duly called and notice thereof given in accordance with the law; that said election was held in a manner required by law, that only duly qualified electors of said City voted in said election; that due returns of said election have been made by the proper officials; that said election has resulted favorably in the adoption of a one percent sales and use tax within the Village of Wimberley.
