

RESOLUTION NO. R-033-2002

RESOLUTION CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF ELECTION HELD ON MAY 4, 2002 TO DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT TO ABOLISH THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, HAYS COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, there was held in the Village of Wimberley, Hays County, Texas on the 4th day of May, 2002, an election to determine whether or not to abolish the Village of Wimberley, Hays County, Texas, and it appearing from the returns that there were cast at said election, by the duly qualified electors of said City, 1,247 votes which were cast as follows:

AGAINST THE ABOLITION OF THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS	726


all as reflected by said official election returns heretofore submitted to the City Council of said City by Joyce Cowan, Hays County Election Administrator, and accepted by said City on the 4th day of May, 2002, as the official results of the election of May 4, 2002, and declare as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS:




