

RESOLUTION NO. R-04-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS TO DREDGE PORTIONS OF THE BLANCO RIVER, CYPRESS CREEK, AND PIERCE CREEK TO OFFSET THE EFFECTS OF THE OCTOBER 31, 2013 FLOODS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wimberley, Texas (“Council”) seeks to provide for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wimberley seeks to protect its waterways within the City Limits, including, but not limited to, the Blanco River, Cypress Creek, and Pierce Creek; and

WHEREAS, the October 31, 2013 floods caused deposits of gravel, sediment, and other debris at unprecedented levels in the City’s waterways; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified areas in which such deposits have not dissipated by natural means and are threatening the health and safety of the waterways and surrounding environment and of those who use them for recreation or other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the use of public funds to dredge portions of the Blanco River, Cypress Creek, and Pierce Creek to counteract the harmful effects of the October 31, 2013 floods will serve a public purpose that will benefit all citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS, THAT:

The Council authorizes the City Administrator to contribute City resources in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the purpose of dredging portions of the Blanco River, Cypress Creek, and Pierce Creek to the extent necessary to counteract the harmful effects of the October 31, 2013 floods.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This RESOLUTION shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of approval.
