A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF GOVERNOR RICK PERRY'S DECLARATION OF MARCH 2-8, 2003 AS SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS WEEK.

WHEREAS, Severe Weather Awareness Week is March 2-8, 2003, and

WHEREAS, each year brings the potential for violent weather to Texas; and

WHEREAS, large portions of our state, including the Village of Wimberley and properties within its extraterritorial jurisdiction can be devastated by flooding, tornadoes, windstorms and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Emergency Management, Texas Department of Public Safety, the National Weather Service and FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency) have joined together in urging all citizens to prepare for severe weather events and to educate themselves on safety strategies; and

WHEREAS, Governor Rick Perry has declared the week of March 2-8, 2003 as Severe Weather Awareness Week in Texas,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council and Mayor of the Village of Wimberley urge everyone in our community to learn more about and to participate in severe weather preparedness activities available in the Village of Wimberley.

THEREFORE, in official recognition of this statewide event, I, Tony McGee, Mayor, do hereby proclaim March 2-8, 2003 as
