

RESOLUTION NO. R-43-2003

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CAPITAL AREA REGIONAL
TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S TRANSPORTA-
TION DELEGATION AND SELECTED PRIORITY PROJECTS.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Wimberley is committed to improving safety and mobility on Central Texas roadways, and,

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Regional Transportation Planning Organization exists to serve as the catalyst for transportation planning and project implementation that anticipates and meets regional infrastructure requirements, and,

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Regional Transportation Planning Organization represents the ten-county CAPCO region that includes the Village of Wimberley; and

WHEREAS, a Capital Area Regional Transportation Planning Organization Delegation will be appearing before the Texas Transportation Commission on April 24, 2003 to request Strategic Priority Funding for three projects that will improve safety and mobility in Central Texas, and,

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Regional Transportation Planning Organization participated in a detailed, region-wide project evaluation and selection process and unanimously approved the three projects that will be presented to the Commission, and,

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Regional Transportation Planning Organization selected the following three projects as the Region's 2003 priorities: (1) Widen US 290(E) east of Giddings to 4-lanes divided; (2) Construct main lanes, frontage roads, and grade separations on SH 71 west of and through the City of Bastrop; and (3) Widen US 290(E) east of Elgin to 4-lanes divided, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY that the city supports the Capital Area Regional Transportation Planning Organization's Transportation Delegation and selected priority projects.
