

RESOLUTION NO. R-68-2003

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS,
ESTABLISHING AN INTERJURISDICTIONAL EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Wimberley ("Village") by Ordinance No. 2003-008 and Hays County ("County") by Commissioners Court Order dated 12/23/03, have established similar programs of comprehensive emergency management which includes the mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery phases of emergency management; and

WHEREAS, the Village and County find that vulnerability to many potential hazards is shared by residents of the Village of Wimberley, and the unincorporated portions of Hays County; and

WHEREAS, the Village and County further find that the common goal of emergency management can best be achieved through an organization which shares the combined resources of the Village and the County; and

WHEREAS, the contemplated action is specifically authorized by the aforementioned Ordinance and Court Order;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Wimberley and Hays County:

I. INTERJURISDICTIONAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

A. There is hereby established the Hays County Emergency Management organization which shall consist of the officers and employees of the Village and the County as designated in an interjurisdictional emergency management plan, together with such organized and other volunteer groups as that plan may specify; and

B. The Mayor of the Village of Wimberley and the Hays County Judge shall mutually appoint an Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate all aspects of the Village of Wimberley/Hays County program of comprehensive emergency management, including the preparation of and maintenance of an interjurisdictional emergency management plan for the Village of Wimberley and Hays County in accordance with this Resolution.

II. SEVERABILITY

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Village and County that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Resolution be severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Resolution shall be declared

unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this Resolution, and the remainder of this Resolution shall be enforced as written.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as may be required by governing law.

IV. PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.



Village of Wimberley






