**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF
CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS EXTENSION OF FM 3407**

WHEREAS, The City of San Marcos has applied for a pass through toll agreement for the extension of FM 3407 from Hunter Road to RM 12; and

WHEREAS, The State of Texas has adopted Minute Order 108745 agreeing to partner with the city concerning advanced planning for this project; and


WHEREAS, The City of San Marcos has already invested approximately \$5.6 million towards this project, this roadway will be a limited access roadway therefore not increasing traffic due to secondary growth and development over the Edwards Aquifer; and


WHEREAS, a toll feasibility study has been conducted by TxDOT and has concluded that this roadway is not financially toll viable:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS: Because of the importance of this project to the City of San Marcos and the entire Wimberley Valley and also understanding the current financial constraints of TxDOT that the Village of Wimberley supports the City of San Marcos's application for a pass through toll agreement and request favorable consideration by the Transportation Commission.
