RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS IN SUPPORT OF THE JOINT REQUEST BY THE WIMBERLEY COMMUNITY TENNIS ASSOCIATION AND THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES TENNIS ASSOCIATION TO HELP FUND THE DEVELOPMENT OF TENNIS COURTS AT THE BLUE HOLE REGIONAL PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Wimberley is proud to support the Wimberley Community Tennis Association in its efforts to and build community tennis courts;

WHEREAS, there is a definite need for this project and the goals of this project serve the public interests of our City in promoting tennis as a recreational activity;


WHEREAS, various community and tennis-related programs will be implemented that will enhance the lives of all residents in the Wimberley Valley;

WHEREAS, the City of Wimberley desires to partner with the Wimberley Community Tennis Association by jointly requesting up to \$60,000 in public facility funding assistance from the United States Tennis Association to help fund the development of the tennis courts at Blue Hole Regional Park, to be used by those who live, work, and visit here;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS, we offer our full support to the Wimberley Community Tennis Association's joint request with the City of Wimberley seeking grant funding from the United States Tennis Association to help fund the development and construction of tennis courts at the Blue Hole Regional Park.
