CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS MONTH

April 2005

WHEREAS, the people of Wimberley pride themselves on giving to their community, contributing to the quality of life among our citizens and caring for their children; and

WHEREAS, Roxanne's House, the Children's Advocacy Center of Hays and Caldwell Counties, a program within the Hays Caldwell Women's Center, all work to protect abuse and neglected children; and

WHEREAS, the National Child Abuse and Neglect Data Systems has reported that nearly 900,000 children a year are the victims of mistreatment and abuse across America; and

WHEREAS, Wimberley citizens are encouraged to join a national effort to increase awareness of child abuse and to offer comfort to those children who have fallen victim to abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS, this effort will give abuse and neglected children in our community and around the country a chance for a safe and positive future;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the City Council of the Village of Wimberley, by virtue of the authority vested in us, by the citizens of the Village of Wimberley, Texas, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 2005 as



CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS MONTH


