

RESOLUTION NO. 101-2005

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS, RELATING TO THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY TO AMEND THE VILLAGE'S SEWER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Wimberley ("Village") was granted Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") No. 20936 on January 6, 2005, by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;

WHEREAS, the Village has received a request for service form the Wimberley Independent School District ("District") to provide sewer service to the property that the District intends to purchase and has under contract for a new school along the Ranch Road 12 Bypass ("District property");

WHEREAS, the District property is not currently certificated to the Village or to any other retail service provider;

WHEREAS, the Village is aware that other landowners in the vicinity of the District property may also have a need for sewer service; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village to amend its Sewer CCN No. 20936 to include the District property along with other additional property within the vicinity of the District property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor of the Village of Wimberley is hereby authorized to file an application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to amend the Village's Sewer CCN No. 20936 to reflect the areas shown on the attached map and to take all action necessary to obtain an amended sewer CCN. All actions taken in this regard to date are hereby ratified.


Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
