A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE UNITED STATES CENSUS 2010

WHEREAS, The census is a count of everyone residing in the United States - people of all races and ethnic groups, both citizens and non-citizens; and

WHEREAS, The United States Constitution requires a national census once every 10 years. Census Day is April 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Every year, the federal government can allocate more than \$300 billion to states and communities based, in part, on census data; and


