

RESOLUTION NO. 16-2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS IN SUPPORT OF EXTENDING THE HAYS COUNTY - CITY OF WIMBERLEY REGIONAL HIKE AND BIKE TRAIL ALONG BLUE HOLE LANE AND OLD KYLE ROAD.

WHEREAS, the City of Wimberley is located in Hays County, one of the fastest growing counties in the State of Texas and the United States; and

WHEREAS, the heart and economic core of Wimberley is its central business district which receives tens of thousands of visitors a year; and

WHEREAS, the City's Blue Hole Regional Park is a destination of interest and receives approximately 46,000 visitors from outside the 78676 zip code; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide a safe multi-modal and pedestrian friendly connection between The City of Woodcreek, Blue Hole Regional Park and to the central business district along Blue Hole Lane and Old Kyle Road; and

WHEREAS, an extension of the hike and bike trail from the Blue Hole Regional Park to the central business district along Blue Hole Lane and Old Kyle Road would not only provide for pedestrian safety but would also meet the objectives of the City's Parks and Recreation Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WIMBERLEY, TEXAS:

That the City Council is supportive and committed to working with Hays County to extend the Hays County-City of Wimberley Regional Hike and Bike Trail along Blue Hole Lane and Old Kyle Road, to provide for better pedestrian safety and connectivity.
