Minutes of January 2, 2002 Meeting

Call to Order and Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 10:00AM by John Graddy. Present Frank Austin, Parker Burgin, Bill Johnson, Gene Woodruff, and John Graddy.

Approval Of Minutes of December 19, 2001 Meeting

Status Reports

Solicitation of Interest in Road Work - Woodruff

Gene reported that he has received only one response expressing interest in performing road work for the Village. Myers construction responded positively and requested specifications for doing the work.

School Bus Loading/Unloading - Carr

Gentry was not present tp give a report.

Wimberley "Adopt-a-Road" Program - Nichols

Carolyn was not present to give a report.

Discussion

Coordination of County Road Work in Village

John pointed out that county work crews currently do work at the request of any local resident that calls in. The procedure is for a road crew supervisor to investigate the request, and, if he agrees that the work is necessary, it is performed. John suggested that the village should be involved in coordinating and prioritizing requests so that the highest priority jobs are done first. The majority of the board felt that the current procedure is satisfactory.

Pothole Repair Demo

Gentry was not present to discuss the proposed demo.

Letter to TxDOT

It had been reported at the previous meeting that this traffic light occasionally failed to give a green signal to River Road traffic, causing people to finally run the red light. John reported that he had taken time to observe the light for a couple of one hour periods and that the light had never malfunctioned. Other members assured him that it does, indeed, occasionally malfunction. John agreed to write a letter to TxDOT about the light.

Carolyn was not present to discuss the status of this project.

Public Comment

Comments by Board Members

Frank said that the WISD has scheduled a meeting to discuss traffic safety around the schools. The Sheriff's Department, the city, the Precinct 3 Constable, Durham Transportation, Wimberley VFD and others are invited.
