### Minutes of March 6, 2002 Meeting

#### Call to Order and Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM by John Graddy. Present were Parker Burgin, Al Sander, Frank Austin, Gene Woodruff, Bill Johnson, Kelly Kilber, Carolyn Nichols, and John Graddy. City Administrator Steve Harrison also attended.

#### Approval of Minutes of February 20, 2002 Meeting.

Minutes of the meeting were approved as written.

#### Status Reports

##### Parking Ordinance - Austin

The final draft of the Parking Ordinance was received back from the city attorney. This draft was reviewed in detail. The maximum fine allowed by the ordinance was reduced from \$500 to \$250. The board voted to forward the ordinance to the city council.

##### 7-A Ranch Bridge

Kelly has talked to All-pro plumbing of San Antonio about cleaning our the culverts. The need to place the grates was also discussed. It was agreed that the are necessary and that it would be desirable to have them replaced efore the swimming season. Parker will check with local welding shops to determine interest.

##### Purchase of Barriers - Burgin

Parker is in the process of creating a list of barricades, cones, safety vests, etc. for purchase by the city. At this point, it appears that funding in the amount of \$6000-\$7000 will be necessary.

##### Making Loma Vista a Private Road

John reported that he had not yet talked to any property owners about making Loma Vista a private road. Al suggested that Sally Wilcox be called concerning the previous request by property owners to take over the road.
