

MINUTES OF MEETING
MARCH 12, 2014



The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Woodruff at 0855AM.

A. MINUTES

The minutes of the last regular meeting on February 12th, were read and approved upon a motion by Bob Bullock and a second by Donald Black.

B. CITIZEN COMMUNICATIONS: None

C. STAFF REPORTS:

The City Administrator reported on the following items.

1. The truck route signage is up and appears to be working well. There has been some vocal opposition from some of the local dump truck drivers, which is understandable as they have been driving through the downtown area for years. Very few complaints from the local citizenry, with the exception of the sign location and it's implications on 2325.

2. In reference to the halloween flood damage, it is expected that FEMA will wrap up their reporting processes around the end of the month. City Staff has been working with FEMA on extensive damage on 1492 and Flite Acres Rd., as well as other locations. The anticipated cost of repairs will be substantial and the approval waiting period is anticipated to be about 45 days.

3. Just for informational purposes, there is possibly some changes that will be made in the future by TXDOT regarding the designations of RR12 as a business or alternate route through the downtown area. If an when that happens, RR12 would be designated as the Winters Mill Parkway bypass.

E. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION:

1. Turn lanes and/or deceleration lanes were discussed relating to the Wimberley Hills, Spoke Hollow and Cypress Creek Lane locations. A motion was made by Donald Black and second by Bob Bullock, to propose that the City Council notify TXDOT of their support for these needed improvements. The motion was passed by a unanimous vote.

2. Discussion continued relating to CAMPO, and their future meetings related to long range plans that will effect the residents of the Wimberley Valley. There are some anticipated amendments to be made that will directly effect traffic patterns traveling to or away from Wimberley. The next public meeting relating to these proposed amendments will be on April 2nd at the San Marcos Activity Center. Bert Ray made a motion and a second by Bob Bullock to encourage City Council to participate, either directly at the meeting or through written correspondence. The motion passed by unanimous vote.
