Minutes of Meeting  
June 12, 2013

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Gene Woodruff at 09:02AM

A. MINUTES

The last meeting of the TAB was an open meeting/public hearing on the request to place traffic stripes on Flite Acres Rd. No minutes of the meeting were taken, due to a recorded transcript.

B. STAFF REPORTS

The City Administrator reported on the following items:

1. The letters were placed on the wall, as part of the Old Kyle Rd./Downtown improvement project by Signcrafters. Everyone appears to be pleased with the results. Having some problems with the larger trees planted as part of the project. The City Staff is working with an arborist to try to save the trees as evidently they were stressed when planted. Phosphorus and air posts have been added to try to assist the trees in root development. The crosswalk hump on RR12 has been fixed.

D. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION:

1. The Flite Acres Rd. traffic stripe project: The public hearing held 05/22/13 was attended by three residents of the Flite Acres Rd. neighborhood. Of the three present, there was obviously mixed feelings about the proposed project. However, the mail out request for opinions, from the residents of the effected area resulted in a total of 29 responses. These written responses were overwhelmingly in favor of placing the traffic stripes. The written responses/votes were 19 for and 10 against.

2. The TAB also discussed the real need for traffic stripes on Old Kyle Rd. It was suggested that this could be done in conjunction with the Flite Acres project, if indeed the City Council approves that action.

3. TAB member Bob Bullock made a motion to recommend traffic stripes be placed on Flite Acres Rd., which was seconded by TAB member Bert Ray. The motion made was to recommend to the council that a minimum of a center stripe be painted on Flite Acres Rd., with the City Council and County Officials to make the determination of how many stripes should be used. The TAB members voted unanimously in favor or the motion, with all members present.

#### E. BOARD MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS:

1. TAB member Bob Bullock voiced some concerns about old cars being parked in yards. The City Administrator advised if the vehicle are registered and operable, there was nothing the city could do.
