MINUTES OF MEETING  
AUGUST 10, 2016

This meeting was called to order by Chairman Bob Bullock at 9:01 a.m.

3. Reports

A. City Staff Reports

City Administrator Ferguson reported that the bid for the road improvements on La Buena Vista would be submitted by September. Mr. Ferguson also reported that Mayor McCullough had filed the budget and that the River Road improvements are moving forward and will include a retaining wall in some areas and some drainage and retaining wall work at Wilson Creek. The project should take approximately 30 days to complete once construction begins and at times River Road will be closed to traffic in the construction area. All residents in the area will be notified to take alternate routes.

4. Public Hearing and Consider Action

Hold a public hearing and consider action regarding the proposed permanent closure of the portion of Savage Lane between River Road and the intersection of Savage Lane and Wilson Creek Circle.

The visitors present were in attendance to voice their concerns and opinions on the proposed permanent closure of Savage Lane. All of those present spoke of their concerns. Most were concerned that the postal delivery service would be hindered if it were closed, as the mail boxes for the area were on Savage Lane. The majority of the ones who spoke did not want the road closed, as they used it as a way to and from their residence. One person in attendance said she did not want the road closed, as she felt it was a traffic risk to turn onto River Road as you come down Savage Lane and try to merge onto River Road. No further public comments were heard.

Chairman Bullock asked for discussion from Board members and there was none.

Michael Murphy moved that the Board propose not to close Savage Lane. Mike Moeller seconded. Chairman Bullock called for a vote and the motion carried unanimously to not recommend closing Savage Lane.

Discuss and consider possible action regarding a proposal to require address numbering on homes and businesses in the City of Wimberley.
