Discuss and consider possible action regarding County Road 1492 and RR 12 guard rail.



ADJOURNMENT


Motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:41 a.m. was made by TAB Member Gary Callon.

Motion was seconded by TAB Member Jim Chiles. Motion carried unanimously.


